In an effort to provide workforce and business development opportunities to existing business owners, entrepreneurs, and aspiring business professionals in South Orange County, the City of Lake Forest, in partnership with SCORE and neighboring South County cities, created the South Orange County Entrepreneurs Academy. The program is a multi-city and non-profit partnership to match existing programs with regional business needs

Participating cities host these events to increase the visibility and accessibility of these programs while SCORE provides high quality content and speakers for workshop seminars such as Social Media Marketing, Tax Preparation, Human Resources, Management and many more. The City and other neighboring cities value the opportunities that small businesses and entrepreneurship provide for each community. They bring options to our citizens, encourage local commerce, and grow the local economy.

For this reason, we have made small business owners' access to mentorship, education, and training tools a complimentary service in our programming. Earlier this year, the South OC Entrepreneurs Academy was recognized by the American Planners Association (APA) with an Award of Merit for municipal "Best Practices". During the first year of the program, the Academy featured 13 sessions with nearly 400 program attendees.



2019 was a year of much progress and development in the City of Lake Forest. The most exciting achievement of 2019 was the City's move to the new Civic Center Campus. We are excited for all the new activities, opportunities, and amenities our new "100-Year-Home" will offer Lake Forest residents and businesses.

The City continues to be a prime location for new businesses and developments. In addition to the homes under construction near the new Civic Center on Serrano Summit, new businesses such as the Tesla service center and dealership, Pet Wants, Bishops Cuts/Color, At Home, Sprouts and many more opened their doors over the past year. From large retail shops to small neighborhood businesses, Lake Forest continues to be the natural choice and destination for new business establishments and expansions.

With improvements to existing shopping centers such as Heritage Hill Plaza and the ongoing improvements at the Hunter Court Shopping Center, the City continues to retain and attract high quality businesses and restaurants. The construction of three new hotels is well underway and will provide visitors and business travelers with additional options when staying in Lake Forest. The businesses in Lake Forest are valuable partners in shaping our community. In January 2020, Hoag will open a new state-of-the-art and innovative Health Center in the Foothill Ranch Towne Centre.
