2015 SPECIAL OLYMPICS WORLD GAMES 'HOST TOWN' OPPORTUNITY (Agenda Item No. 2)

The City Council received an update on the activities surrounding the 2015 Special Olympics World Games, which will be held in Los Angeles in July 2015. The Special Olympics relies on Host Towns to provide lodging, transportation, workout facilities, and access to community events for the delegations for a few days prior to the Special Olympics Opening Ceremonies. The Cities of Lake Forest and Laguna Hills will co-host 88 athletes from the Cayman Islands and Syria from July 21 - July 24. Social activities may include arts and crafts, a dance, and a trip to the Orange County Fair.

PARKSIDE AT BAKER RANCH DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS (Agenda Item No. 8)

The City Council considered the development of 250 single family residences on a 30-acre site located on Rancho Parkway, directly across from the Lake Forest Sports Park. Baker Ranch Properties submitted a request to rezone the property from commercial to residential use, a Tentative Tract Map, a Development Agreement which provides for fee payments to the City to help fund future public facilities, and a Mitigated Negative Declaration stating that any environmental impacts associated with the project can be adequately mitigated through the development process. The Council conducted a noticed public hearing where 29 people spoke in support of the development and four people spoke in opposition of the development. After concluding public comment, the Council approved the applications.

RECEIVE PRESENTATION FROM IRVINE RANCH WATER DISTRICT FOR RECYLCLING WATER USE AT THE LAKE FOREST SPORTS PARK (Agenda Item No. 3)

The City Council accepted the California Recycled Water Customer of the Year Award for the use of recycled water at the Lake Forest Sports Park. As part of the sports park design, irrigation throughout

the park's landscape and the three dual-plumbed park buildings utilize recycled water. The 86-acre facility incorporates the first dual-plumbed buildings within the City that utilizes recycled water for flushing toilets and urinals. In addition, the landscape areas throughout the park uses recycled water resulting in a combined savings of 40 million gallons of drinking water each year.

CONTRACTURAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE LAKE FOREST CHAMBER OF COMMERCE (Agenda Item No. 16)

The City Council approved a one-year Agreement with the Lake Forest Chamber of Commerce for general and special business services. As part of the Agreement, the Chamber plans and implements co-sponsored business events and provides staff with support for the annual Taste of Lake Forest. In addition, the Chamber promotes the City's business resources on its website, via email to its membership, and in business packets distributed throughout the year. The Chamber's business events, networking programs, and general promotion and outreach services effectively complement the City's Business Development and Attraction Program, leading to new businesses joining the City each year.

AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR STREET SWEEPING SERVICES (Agenda Item No. 19)

The City Council moved forward with its commitment to provide quality public service as it approved a new three-year agreement for weekly street sweeping services with Athens Services in the amount of \$951,481. Athens Services will ensure that streets and City-owned public parking lots are swept weekly to maintain a high quality aesthetic appearance.
