# CITY COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

### **August 4, 2015**

AGREEMENT WITH SADDLEBACK VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PROVIDE KIDS' CLUB AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS (Agenda Item No. 6)

City Council approved an agreement with Saddleback Valley Unified School District to continue providing the Kids' Factory After School Program at eight school sites. The drop-in program provides a structured and supervised environment for K-6 children whose parents are not at home during afterschool hours. The three-year agreement is valued at \$1,474,855.

# CONTRACT FOR CROSSING GUARD SERVICES (Agenda Item No. 14)

City Council approved a three-year contract with All City Management to station crossing guards at 20 locations near public schools during the morning and afterschool hours. All City Management would provide personnel equipped and trained in appropriate procedures for crossing pedestrians in marked crosswalks, as well as supervisory personnel to see that crossing guard activities are taking place at the required place and times. The total contract amount is \$808,293.

# APPLICANT INTERVIEWS: CITIZENS TRAFFIC ADVISORY GROUP (Agenda Item No. 16)

City Council interviewed and appointed seven members to the Citizens Traffic Advisory Group (CTAG) responsible for providing findings and recommendations to the City Council on traffic and transportation topics.
